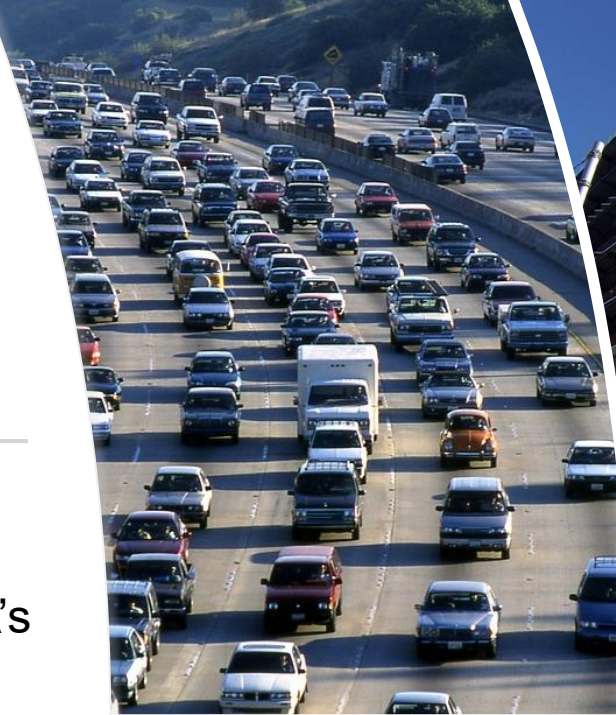
# Transportation

- **AB 6 (Friedman)**
  - ❖ Resets CARB emission reduction targets to 2035 for cars and 2045 for light trucks
  - ❖ Requires MPO's to work w/ CARB on their technical methodologies, adds authority for CARB to approve the methodology
  - ❖ Expands CARB 's ability to review and accept or reject Sustainable Communities Strategies
- **AB 744 (Carrillo)**
  - ❖ Requires the California Transportation Commission (once funded) to:
    - ❖ Acquire or procure licensed data modeling tools to support the state's sustainable transportation,
    - ❖ Provide this planning software to counties & other local governments





# Transportation



- **SB 617 (Newman)**

- ❖ Authorizes counties, county transportation commissions, RTPA's and others to transit agencies, as specified, and to use progressive design-build through Jan. 2029.
- ❖ Each agency allowed to use Prog. DB for up to 10 projects.
- ❖ Each project must be in excess of \$5 million.

# Caltrans Maintenance Agreements

---



- ❖ **Issue:** Caltrans is utilizing a new template for Freeway Maintenance Agreements (FMA).
- ❖ The new agreement appears to shift Caltrans maintenance responsibilities to counties.
- ❖ Engaged with the State Transportation Agency (CalSTA) on issue.
- ❖ CSAC meeting with Caltrans and Legislative Policy Committees to discuss.
