



### Rural Community Feedback

In general, they realize something has to be done and appreciate being invited to the table

- Introduce RUC for EVs only.
  Leave the gas tax in place for us.
- We are the tradeoff: rural communities get overlooked in legislative debates.
- Need increased funding for rural roads.
- Interest in tourist counties to add VMT to the funding distribution equations.
- Concerns people will no longer register their vehicles.

- Fear of being double taxed. Skeptical gas tax will go away.
- Would RUC revenue be guaranteed for funding roads and bridges only?
- Revenue will go farther if you get rid of prevailing wage.
- This is a step toward controlling driving behavior.
- Privacy Concerns Why does the government need to know my mileage?

Ex: Monthly fuel-tax paid for 1,250 Miles Driven Low Efficiency Average Efficiency \$8.50\* Electric Car






## What drivers pay under Road Charge

### Tribal Feedback

"For 2023, Cahuilla received \$34,000 from the BIA to maintain our main roads throughout the reservation.
That funding is for 18 miles of road."

- Strong opposition, especially in the south
- Exemptions expected
- Frustration over funding levels
- Prefer EV only RUC
- Effect on gas stations a key issue
