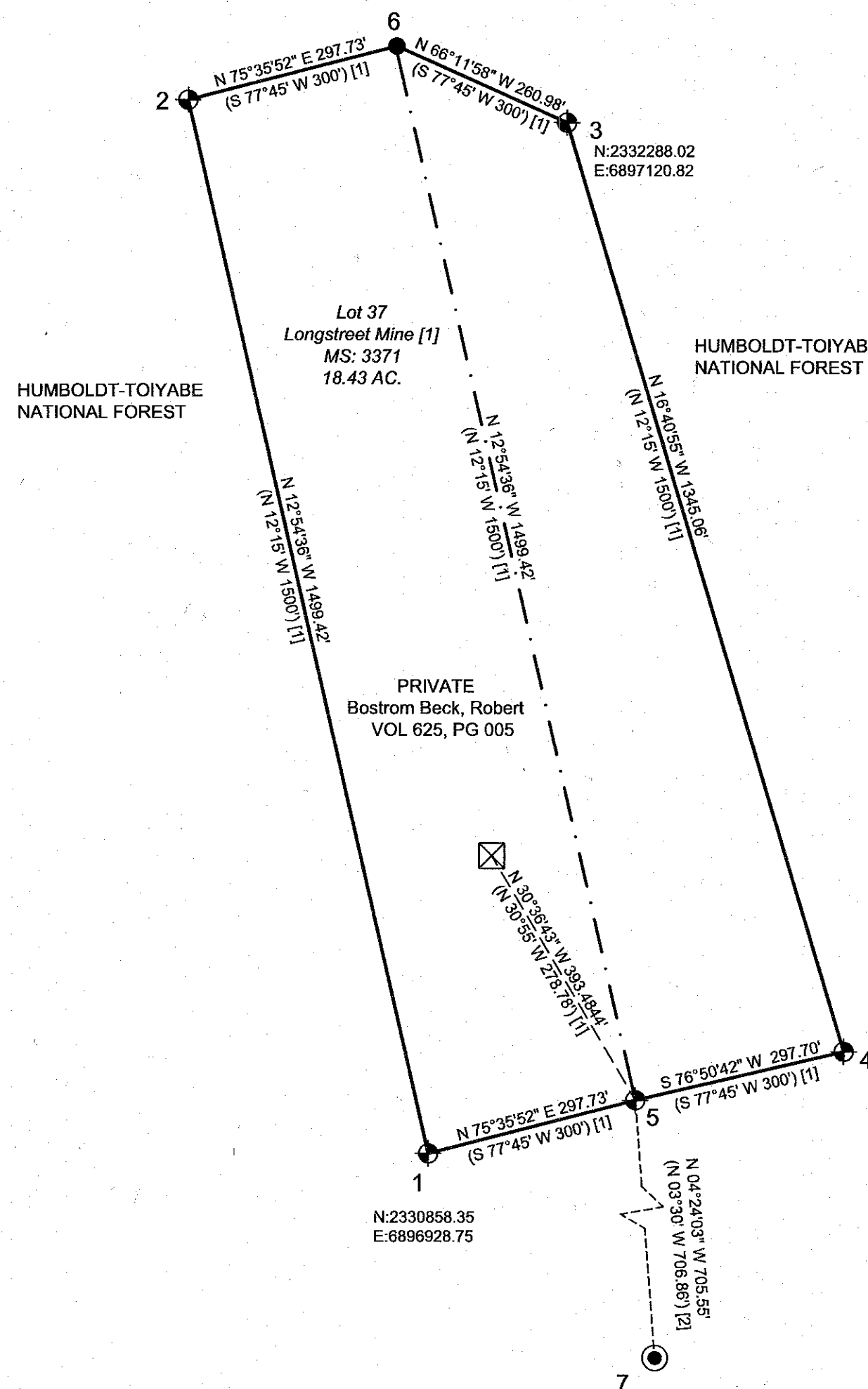
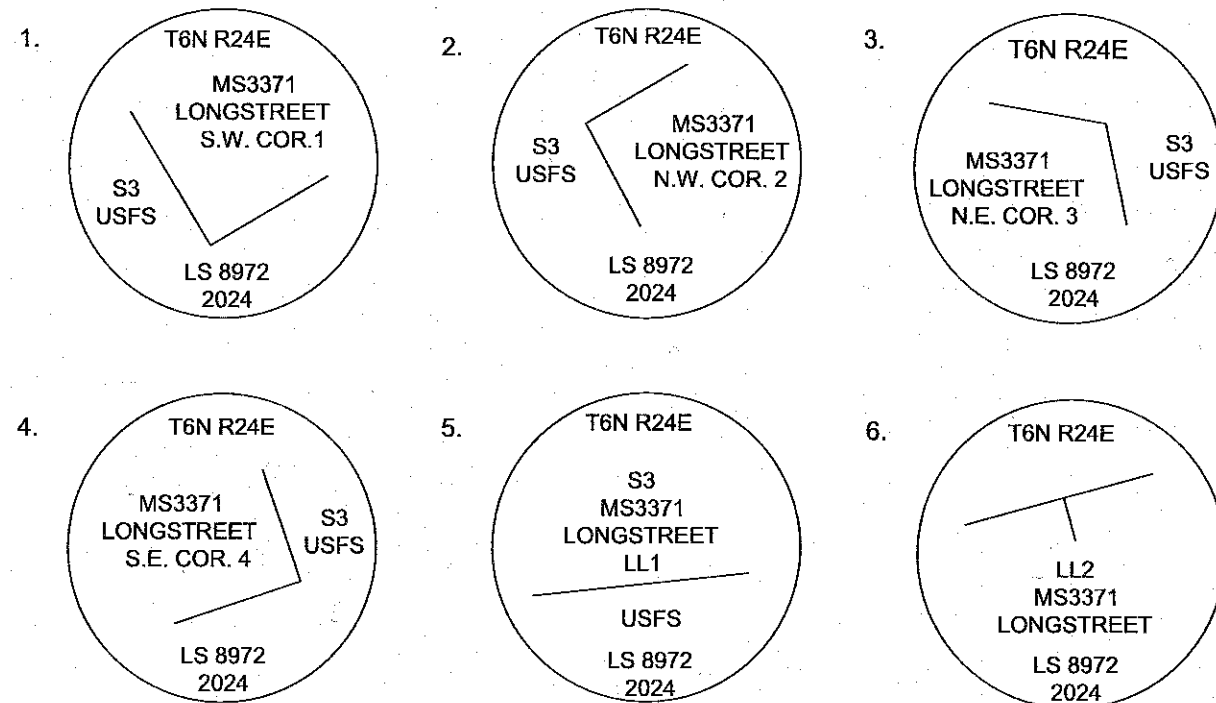

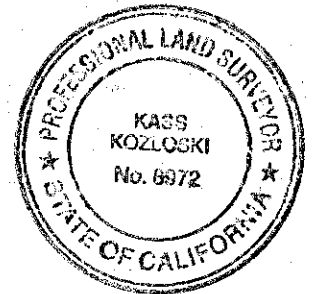
- Found evidence of original wood post next to apparent MOS. Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC at post's location. New BT: 11" ponderosa pine N 63°03' W, 127.0'
- Found original 4x4 wood post upright in scree field marked "LONGSTREET, NW COR. 2". Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC at post's location. No BT
- Found a 4x4 wood post marked "LONGSTREET" and "NE" next to a 4' diameter MOS. Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC in center of original MOS. New BT: 13" pine tree N 83°53' E, 50.5'
- Found evidence of original wood post and 3' diameter MOS. Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC in center of original MOS. New BT: 10" pine tree S 10°42' E, 32.0'
- Found evidence of original wood post and 4' diameter MOS. Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC in center of original MOS. New BT: 16" juniper tree S 19°42' E, 69.7'
- Searched for monument, no evidence found. Set standard USFS 2.5" APAC with the intent of keeping the lode line parallel with the westerly boundary of the mineral survey. No BT
- Found 2 1/2" brass GLO cap on 1" pipe marked 1/4 COR. S3/S10. BT: 18" pine tree snag S 77°46' W, 35.5', 19" pine tree S 36°05' E, 25.4' [2]

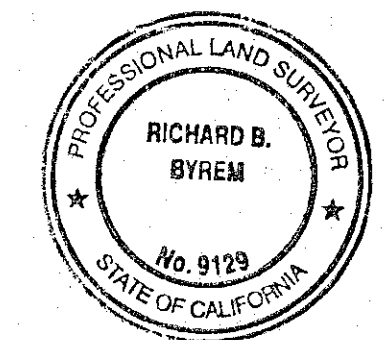
