2025 County Engineers Association of California (CEAC) Memorial Scholarship Program

The County Engineers Association of California will grant up to **TWO (2) \$3,000 cash** scholarships to qualified Engineering or Land Surveying students for study leading to a bachelor's degree in civil engineering or land surveying.

Each student must be enrolled in upper division course work leading to a Civil Engineering or Land Surveying Degree, with a high-grade point average, have demonstrated a need for the scholarship, and have participated in related outside activities such as a Student Chapter ASCE, Student Member CLSA or American Public Works Association. These several factors, including outside activities, will be considered in awarding the scholarship.
